

The Ohio State University Transfer Module Description and Requirements

Instructions

The Transfer Module must include 54 quarter credit hours of introductory courses in the following areas: English composition, mathematics, arts and humanities, social science, and natural science. Students should follow these directions in selecting courses for the transfer module.

► Select the minimum area requirements from the introductory courses marked with a star (★) in each section.

► Complete the required total minimum hours of the transfer module from the remaining courses on this list.

NOTE: To assure the most efficient transfer of academic credit, be sure to check with an academic adviser to select the courses most appropriate for the general education requirements and/or major at the transfer college or university selected.
